(5) THE COMPENSATION OF THE EMPLOYEES LISTED IN PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT EXCEED THE HIGHEST GRADE AND STEP OR HIGHEST FIXED RATE AMOUNT PROVIDED UNDER THE EXECUTIVE PAY PLAN ESTABLISHED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF \$ 6-102-(B) OF THE STATE PERSONNEL AND PENSIONS ARTICLE THE FOLLOWING EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE EXECUTIVE PAY PLAN ESTABLISHED UNDER THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE PERSONNEL ARTICLE FOR EXECUTIVE MANAGEMENT POSITIONS IN STATE GOVERNMENT. THE COMPENSATION OF EACH EMPLOYEE MAY NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT PROVIDED FOR THE HIGHEST STEP OF THE GRADE LISTED BELOW FOR THAT EMPLOYEE UNDER THE CURRENT EXECUTIVE PAY PLAN IN EFFECT FOR THE APPLICABLE FISCAL YEAR:
