- (3) BEFORE AN INSPECTION CERTIFICATE OR PROOF OF INSPECTION CERTIFICATE MAY BE ISSUED, THE PERSON SEEKING TO OBTAIN THE INSPECTION CERTIFICATE OR PROOF OF INSPECTION CERTIFICATE SHALL PROVIDE TO AN INSPECTION STATION PROOF OF OWNERSHIP OF THE USED VEHICLE IN THE FORM OF A CERTIFICATE OF TITLE OR A CURRENT REGISTRATION CARD.
- (4) (I) ANY PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE FINED SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$250.
- (II) THE OFFERING FOR SALE OF EACH USED VEHICLE WITHOUT AN INSPECTION CERTIFICATE OR PROOF OF INSPECTION CERTIFICATE SHALL BE A SEPARATE OFFENSE OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- [(3)](D) If a used vehicle is transferred other than by voluntary transfer or is transferred by a political subdivision of the State after that subdivision obtains the vehicle by proceedings pursuant to Article 27, § 297 of the Code, the transferee shall obtain the inspection certificate from an authorized inspection station. The inspection certificate shall be issued without charge and attached to a window of the vehicle.
- [(4)](E) In the case of a transfer of any used vehicle registered, or to be registered, as a Class E (truck) exceeding three-fourths ton manufacturer's rated capacity, Class F (tractor), Class G (freight trailer or semitrailer), or Class G (dump service semitrailer) vehicle, the transferor or the transferee of the vehicle may obtain the required inspection certificate.
- (F) UNLESS EXEMPTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, IN THE CASE OF A TRANSFER OF ANY USED VEHICLE THAT WAS REPOSSESSED BY A LIENHOLDER, THE TRANSFEREE OF THE VEHICLE SHALL OBTAIN THE REQUIRED INSPECTION CERTIFICATE.
- (G) IN THE CASE OF A TRANSFER OF ANY USED VEHICLE THAT OCCURS AS A RESULT OF A PUBLIC AUCTION SALE, THE TRANSFEREE OF THE VEHICLE SHALL OBTAIN THE REQUIRED INSPECTION CERTIFICATE AND THE TRANSFEROR SHALL PROVIDE WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE TRANSFEREE OF THE INSPECTION CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENT UNDER § 23–107 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- [(5)] (F) (G) (H) In the case of a transfer of any used vehicle registered or to be registered, that is sold for dismantling or rebuilding purposes, the transferor or the transferee of the vehicle may obtain the required inspection certificate.
- [(6)] (H) (I) On applying for a certificate of title of the vehicle, the transferee shall remove the inspection certificate from the vehicle and present it to the Administration.

The Division shall prepare inspection certificate AND PROOF OF INSPECTION CERTIFICATE forms and provide them without charge to inspection stations. The forms shall be serially numbered and shall require the information that the Administration and the Division determine.
