- (2) "ENROLLEE" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL OR MEMBER OF A GROUP TO WHOM A HEALTH NETWORK IS OBLIGATED TO PROVIDE HEALTH CARE SERVICES.
- (3) (I) "HEALTH NETWORK" MEANS A GROUP OF HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS THAT:
- 1. IS ORGANIZED TO PROVIDE HEALTH CARE SERVICES TO AN ENROLLED POPULATION IN A REGIONAL AREA OR SERVICE AREA; AND
- 2. IS RESPONSIBLE FOR DELIVERING OR ARRANGING FOR THE DELIVERY OF THE FULL CONTINUUM OF SERVICES INCLUDED IN A COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN TO ENROLLEES;
  - (II) A HEALTH NETWORK MAY BE FORMED AS EITHER:
    - 1. A PROVIDER HEALTH NETWORK; OR
    - 2. AN INTEGRATED HEALTH NETWORK.
  - (4) "HEALTH PROVIDER" MEANS:
- (I) A PERSON WHO IS LICENSED, CERTIFIED, OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED UNDER THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE TO PROVIDE HEALTH CARE IN THE ORDINARY COURSE OF BUSINESS OR PRACTICE OF A PROFESSION OR IN AN APPROVED EDUCATION OR TRAINING PROGRAM; OR
- (II) A FACILITY WHERE HEALTH CARE IS PROVIDED TO PATIENTS OR RECIPIENTS, INCLUDING A FACILITY AS DEFINED IN § 10–101(E) OF THE HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE, A HOSPITAL AS DEFINED IN § 19–301(F) OF THE HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE, A RELATED INSTITUTION AS DEFINED IN § 19–301(L) OF THE HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE, AN OUTPATIENT CLINIC, AND A MEDICAL LABORATORY.
- (5) "INTEGRATED HEALTH NETWORK" MEANS A NETWORK JOINTLY OWNED OR CONTROLLED BY HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS OR PAYORS THAT CONTRACTS DIRECTLY WITH INDIVIDUALS, EMPLOYERS, OR ORGANIZATIONS TO PROVIDE A HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN AND RETAINS THE RISK FOR DELIVERING OR ARRANGING FOR THE DELIVERY OF THE FULL CONTINUUM OF SERVICES INCLUDED IN A COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN.
  - (6) "PAYOR" MEANS A:
- (I) HEALTH INSURER OR NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN THAT HOLDS A CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY AND PROVIDES HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES OR CONTRACTS IN THE STATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS ARTICLE OR THE HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE;
- (II) HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION THAT IS LICENSED IN THE STATE; OR
- (III) THIRD PARTY ADMINISTRATOR OR ANY ENTITY UNDER CONTRACT WITH A MARYLAND BUSINESS TO ADMINISTER HEALTH CARE BENEFITS.
