

(C) TYPES OF SERVICE CREDIT — MEMBERS OF THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

A MEMBER OF THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM MAY PURCHASE SERVICE CREDIT FOR A PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT:

(1) NOT EXCEEDING 10 YEARS OF OUT-OF-STATE PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHING SERVICE OR NONPUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHING SERVICE;

(2) NOT EXCEEDING 10 YEARS OF FEDERAL SERVICE OR OUT-OF-STATE SERVICE WITH A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION; OR

(3) AS AN EMPLOYEE OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE IF:

(I) THE MEMBER IS NOT OTHERWISE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE SERVICE CREDIT FOR THE SAME PERIOD UNDER THIS DIVISION II;

(II) THE MEMBER IS NOT RECEIVING RETIREMENT BENEFITS FROM A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE FOR THE SAME PERIOD; AND

(III) THE MEMBER, THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION, OR BOTH, PAY THE AMOUNT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(1) OF THIS SECTION.

(D) SAME — MEMBERS OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

A MEMBER OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM MAY PURCHASE SERVICE CREDIT FOR A PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT:

(1) NOT EXCEEDING 10 YEARS OF OUT-OF-STATE PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHING SERVICE, NONPUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHING SERVICE, OR POSTSECONDARY TEACHING SERVICE;

(2) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1970, WITH BALTIMORE CITY AS A TEACHER ON A VERIFIED LEAVE OF ABSENCE NOT EXCEEDING 2 YEARS THAT IS SIMILAR IN ALL RESPECTS TO LEAVES OF ABSENCE APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES;

(3) NOT EXCEEDING 10 YEARS OF FEDERAL OR OUT-OF-STATE MUNICIPAL SERVICE; OR

(4) EMPLOYMENT AS AN EMPLOYEE OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE IF THE MEMBER IS NOT OTHERWISE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE SERVICE CREDIT UNDER THIS DIVISION II.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 73B, §§ 2-305 and 3-305.

In subsection (a) of this section, the phrase "for which the member is not otherwise entitled to service credit" is added to clarify that a member may not receive duplicate service credit for the same period of employment.
