23-207. SAME — TRANSFER FROM TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

A MEMBER OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM MAY TRANSFER MEMBERSHIP TO THE TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM AS OF THE FIRST DAY OF A MONTH IF THE MEMBER FILES WITH THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AN EXECUTED WAIVER OF ALL BENEFITS TO WHICH THE MEMBER MAY BE ENTITLED UNDER THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 23–209 OF THIS SUBTITLE, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN § 23–206(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE WHO BECOMES EMPLOYED BY A PARTICIPATING EMPLOYER ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1980, OR WHO TRANSFERS MEMBERSHIP FROM THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, IS A MEMBER OF THE TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM AS A CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT.
