TITLE 24. STATE POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

SUBTITLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

24-101. SCOPE OF TITLE.

THIS TITLE APPLIES TO THE STATE POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

SUBTITLE 2. MEMBERSHIP.

24-201. MEMBERSHIP IN THE STATE POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM — SCOPE.

THIS SUBTITLE APPLIES ONLY TO:

- AND
- (1) A POLICE EMPLOYEE AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 88B, § 2 OF THE CODE;
  - (2) A MARYLAND STATE POLICE CADET.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 73B, § 6-101(f)(1) and (j).

This section is set forth as a scope provision instead of definitions since the definitions of “State Police officer” and “[s]ervice” in former Art. 73B, § 6-101 served as scope provisions.
