## SUBTITLE 3. SERVICE CREDIT.

## 24-301. IN GENERAL.

A MEMBER IS ENTITLED TO:

- (1) ELIGIBILITY SERVICE AS PROVIDED IN §§ 24–303 THROUGH 24–306 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
  - (2) CREDITABLE SERVICE AS PROVIDED IN § 24–307 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

## 24–302. SERVICE CREDIT — RULES FOR COMPUTATION.

(A) REGULATIONS.

SUBJECT TO SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT SPECIFY THE PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT IN A YEAR THAT IS EQUAL TO 1 YEAR OF SERVICE CREDIT.
