- (2) CREDIT FOR UNUSED SICK LEAVE AS PROVIDED IN § 20–206 OF THIS ARTICLE.

SUBTITLE 4. SERVICE RETIREMENT BENEFITS.

24-401, SERVICE RETIREMENT.

(A) AGE AND SERVICE REQUIREMENT — AT MEMBER'S OPTION.

A MEMBER MAY RETIRE WITH A NORMAL SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE IF:

- (1) ON OR BEFORE THE DATE OF RETIREMENT, THE MEMBER:
 - (I) HAS AT LEAST 25 YEARS OF ELIGIBILITY SERVICE; OR
 - (II) IS AT LEAST 50 YEARS OLD; AND
- (2) THE MEMBER COMPLETES AND SUBMITS A WRITTEN APPLICATION TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES PROVIDES, STATING THE DATE WHEN THE MEMBER DESIRES TO RETIRE.
 - (B) SAME BY ORDER OF SUPERINTENDENT.
- (1) SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE MAY ORDER A MEMBER WHO IS AT LEAST 50 YEARS OLD TO RETIRE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH AFTER THE MEMBER IS NOTIFIED OF THE SUPERINTENDENT'S ORDER.
