25-402. RETIREMENT AFTER TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP.

(A) SCOPE OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A FORMER MEMBER WHO:

- (1) WAS ELIGIBLE FOR A RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER § 25-401 OF THIS SUBTITLE WHEN THE FORMER MEMBER'S MEMBERSHIP TERMINATED;
- (2) DID NOT SUBMIT A WRITTEN APPLICATION UNDER § 25–401 BEFORE MEMBERSHIP TERMINATED; AND
 - (3) HAS NOT WITHDRAWN ACCUMULATED CONTRIBUTIONS.
 - (B) APPLICATION FOR RETIREMENT; RETROACTIVE PAYMENTS PROHIBITED.
- (1) A FORMER MEMBER DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION MAY RETIRE WITH A RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER § 25–401 OF THIS SUBTITLE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH AFTER THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES RECEIVES A WRITTEN APPLICATION FOR RETIREMENT FROM THE FORMER MEMBER.
- (2) A FORMER MEMBER WHO RETIRES UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT RECEIVE BENEFITS FOR THE PERIOD BEFORE THE FORMER MEMBER SUBMITS A COMPLETED APPLICATION TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.
