- (b) [(i)] (1) The Secretary of Human Resources shall also have attached to the Secretary's office such assistants, professional consultants, and employees as are provided for in the State budget. The Secretary may establish areas of responsibility within the Secretary's office and designate assistants to be in charge of such areas.
- [(ii)](2) All staff assistants in the Secretary's office in charge of particular areas of responsibility and all professional consultants shall be in the unclassified service of the State Personnel Management System and shall serve at the pleasure of the Secretary.
- [(iii)] (3) Except as otherwise provided by law, all other employees of the Secretary's office shall be appointed and removed by the Secretary in accordance with the provisions of the State Personnel Article that govern classified service employees.
