(C) EFFECTIVE DATE.

"EFFECTIVE DATE" MEANS THE DATE THAT AN ELIGIBLE GOVERNMENTAL UNIT COMMENCED OR COMMENCES PARTICIPATION IN AN EMPLOYEES' SYSTEM.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to avoid the repetition of the lengthy reference to "the date that an eligible governmental unit commenced or commences participation in an employees' system".

(D) ELIGIBLE GOVERNMENTAL UNIT.
