"WITHDRAWAL DATE" MEANS THE DATE THAT A WITHDRAWAL BY A PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT FROM THE EMPLOYEES SYSTEMS OR THE LOCAL FIRE AND POLICE SYSTEM TAKES EFFECT.

31-302. WITHDRAWAL GENERALLY.

(A) WITHDRAWAL FROM AN EMPLOYEES' SYSTEM.

THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF A PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT MAY WITHDRAW FROM PARTICIPATION IN THE EMPLOYEES' SYSTEMS AND TRANSFER TO A LOCAL PENSION SYSTEM ANY OF THE FOLLOWING GROUPS OF EMPLOYEES OF THE GOVERNMENTAL UNIT WHO CONSENT TO THE WITHDRAWAL:

- (1) ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT;
- (2) FIRE FIGHTERS,
- (3) LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL; OR
- (4) SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, A HOMOGENEOUS UNIT OF AT LEAST 10 EMPLOYEES.
  - (B) WITHDRAWAL FROM THE LOCAL FIRE AND POLICE SYSTEM.

WITHDRAW FROM PARTICIPATION IN THE LOCAL FIRE AND POLICE SYSTEM AND TRANSFER TO A LOCAL PENSION SYSTEM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OR FIRE FIGHTERS OF THE PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT WHO CONSENT TO THE WITHDRAWAL.
