## 35-202. MEMBERSHIP.

      - THE DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL;
      - 2. THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING;
      - 3. THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION:
      - 4. THE OFFICE OF THE STATE COMPTROLLER:
      - 5. THE OFFICE OF THE STATE TREASURER;
      - 6. THE STATE RETIREMENT AGENCY; OR
      - 7. THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION;
- (II) THREE SHALL BE INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ONE OF THE SUPPLEMENTAL RETIREMENT PLANS, AT LEAST ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE AN EMPLOYEE DESCRIBED IN § 403(B)(1)(A)(II) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE; AND
