For the purposes of referendum and of effecting the coverage of federal old age and [survivors] SURVIVORS' insurance, the State of Maryland is declared to have the option of treating the State Employees' Retirement System as if it were divided into separate retirement systems, one being applicable to employees of the State of Maryland and the other or others being applicable to the employees of any political subdivision who may have been enrolled as members of the State Employees' Retirement System. Also, with respect to the Teachers' Retirement System, the State of Maryland is declared to have the option of treating any institution of higher learning having teachers or other members as members of the Teachers' Retirement System as if that institution of higher learning had a separate retirement system.
