

Article 88B – State Police

15.

(b) In supervising and directing the affairs of the Department and in exercising the powers referred to in the preceding subsection, the authority of the Superintendent shall include, but shall not be limited to, the powers:

(13) To establish and modify systems for the reception, processing, and maintenance of reports and records of occurrences or alleged occurrences of crime and motor vehicle accidents within the State, and of the [administration] ADMINISTRATION, management, and operations of the Department; and to establish procedures, not inconsistent with law, for the safekeeping, copying, and destruction of departmental records;

Article 89 – Miscellaneous Business, Work, and Safety Provisions**ELEVATOR SAFETY**

49B.

(a) An elevator, dumbwaiter, escalator or moving walk may not be operated in any building, structure, or place of employment in the State unless a certificate of registration and inspection for the operation thereof is issued by the Commissioner of Labor and Industry, and unless the certificate remains in effect and is kept posted conspicuously in or on the elevator, dumbwaiter, escalator or moving walk.
