It is the intent of the General Assembly that the University of Maryland System transfer within its working budget amendment process all appropriate funding for the Bowie Service Center among the affected institutions to minimize any adverse impact of this service upon Bowie State University's appropriations and data comparisons while ensuring the reporting accuracy of these data processing costs.
