- (2) Upon approval by the State Board of Education of a County's plan, a County Board shall receive a share of the funds available for targeted poverty grants that is proportional to its share of the statewide number of children living in poverty.
- (3) Grants to individual schools shall not exceed \$1,500 for each student living in poverty attending the school receiving the grant.
- (4) In selecting the schools, the County Board shall give priority to schools with the highest concentration of students living in poverty.
- (5) Grants made under this appropriation may not be used to supplant existing funding for compensatory education programs.
