 yoke & truss me of cart and the right of the said Charles  
 Cornish to a lot of oak wood cut and hauled out in the  
 road near (Mr Keils) Messgate believed to be twenty or  
 twenty five acres, all which property is now in my posses-  
 sion. To have and to hold the same as asembled property  
 bargained and sold to the said Seiv N Wall his executors  
 administrators and assigns present to his and their only  
 proper use and benefit and the said Charles Cornish  
 for myself executors and administrators shall and will  
 warrant and defend by these presents to the said  
 Seiv N Wall his executors and administrators and assigns  
 the said assembled property against me my executors and  
 administrators and against all and every other person  
 or persons whosoever claiming the same in any part  
 thereof. Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my  
 hand and seal this the 19th day of December 1842.
