Provided always and it is declared to be the true intent and meaning of these presents that if the said John H. Carroll do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto said Hooper & Hicks his executor or assigns the full sum of Four Hundred Dollars current money with interest for the same on or before the 21st day of June Eighteen Hundred & forty three then and in such case these presents and every matter and thing herein contained shall cease determine and be utterly void to all intents and purposes any thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding. And the said Jno. H. Carroll for himself promises to pay to Hooper & Hicks the full and just sum of Four Hundred Dollars current money with interest and in case the said John H. Carroll does not pay the above named sum to Hooper & Hicks on or before the 21st day of June Eighteen Hundred & forty three by these presents bargained and sold and every part thereof to Hooper & Hicks his administrators or assigns and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and defend by these presents.
