a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and him the said Charles James }  
I do declare to be henceforth free manumited and discharged from all }  
manner of servitude or services after he arrives to the age of Twenty one years to }  
me my executors or administrators forever. In testimony whereof I have here- }  
unto set my hand and affixed my seal this 21st day of June in the year of our }  
Lord Eighteen Hundred & forty three.
