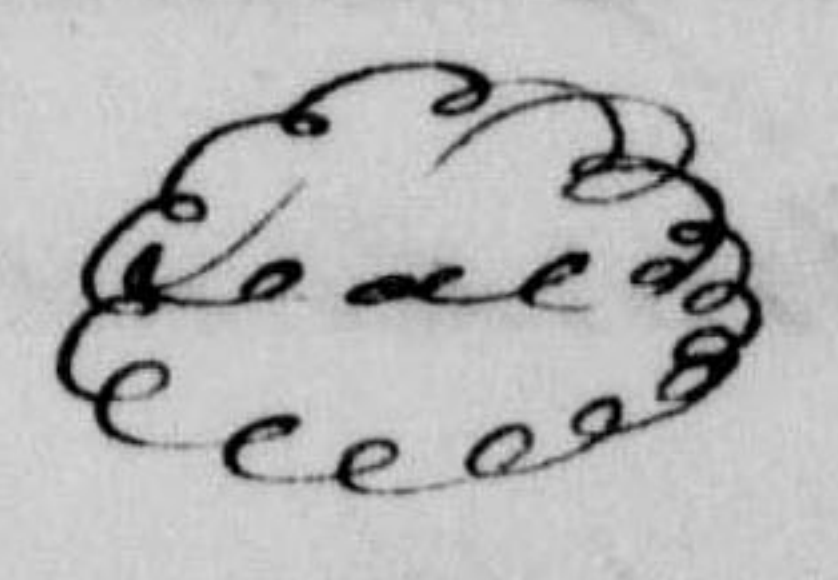

Henry Page near Middle Town in the company of said Johnson. To have and to hold all and singular the Goods Chattels & stock on said premises above bargained and sold. or mentioned or intended or to be. to the said Joseph Bradshaw his. executors. administrators & assigns forever. Provided always and it is. the true intent and meaning. of these presents and of the said parties hereunto. that if the said Henry Johnson shall on or before the first day of August next pay and satisfy. to the said Joseph. Bradshaw the said within named. Consideration of one hundred. and ten. Dollars with Interest from date hereof there and from thence forth. these presents and every matter and thing therein contained shall cease and be utterly null and void any thing. herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding.
