 the sealing and delivery hereof, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge,
 have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain
 and sell unto the said William W. Mitchell, his Executors, Administrators and
 assigns Crop of wheat, Crop of Corn on the ground, Two Carts, four Ploughs,
 one Harrow, one wheat Fan, one mare and Colt, one Yoke Oxen, four Cows,
 four Yearlings, ten head of Sheep, ten head Hogs, two Sows and pigs, Sixty
 Cord Wood in the Woods, lot of Axes, hors and plough gear, with all my
 House hold and Kitchen furniture, all of which property is now in my possession
 to have and to hold the same described property above bargained and sold
 to the said William W. Mitchell, his Executors, administrators and assigns forever,
 to his and their only proper use and benefit. And I the said Aaron Mitchell
 for myself, my Executors and administrators shall and will warrant and
 forever defend by these presents to the said William W. Mitchell, his Executors,
 administrators and assigns, the said described property against me, my Executors
 and administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever,
