Meese his Executors Administrators and Assigns all the good household stuff implements and furniture particularly mentioned expressed and contained in the Schedule hereunto annexed herein particularly mentioned that is to wit one yoke of work steers. one cow and calf one other cow. one steer yearling eight head of sheep. nine head of hogs, two Cows. one ox Cart. one plow. three bedsteads and furniture one clock. two looking glasses, ye dozen stool chair one chest. one lining wheel. one loom and gear two iron pots, two spiders, and one tin kettle two guns all and singular which said goods and chattels are now remaining standing and being in a certain Messuage or tenement situate in Market Neck in the aforesaid County. and now in the Occupation of the said John Shanton of the said and Mary Street— To Have and to Hold all and singular the said good household stuff and furniture and other the premises above bargained and sold or mentioned or intended to be to the said Marcellus D.
