Slave for life and sound in body and mind - to have and to hold, the said Negro Samuel as above bargained and sold, unto the said Samuel Durnock his heirs and assigns forever and assigns against me the said Shadrach Gooter, and my heirs executors and Administrators and against all and every other Person or persons shall and shall warrant and defend. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this fourth day of September 1848.
