Thomas Hubbard here for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to me in hand paid by Mary Jane Hubbard have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Mary Jane Hubbard my negro Girl named Luegray aged three years the fourth part of June Eighteen hundred and forty four, and to her until she is thirty one, and then to her for, and if the said Mary Jane Hubbard should die without heirs to go to her brother and sisters — to Howard to hold the said negro Girl Luegray as above bargained and sold unto the said Mary Jane Hubbard, her heirs executors Administrators and assigns against me the said Thomas Hubbard my heirs executors and Administrators and against all and every other person or persons shall and well warrant and defend In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 24th day of February 1844
