The receipt whereof the Thomas Stuart do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Nathaniel Hearn his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, one bay mare, one sorrel horse, two yoke of oxen, three cows, one yearling one timber cart fifty bannels of corn eight stacks of straw, four leas and four mares, two mares of any talle, one side board, six chains, and one cup board, all of which property are now in my possession. To have and to hold the said bay mare, sorrel horse, two yoke of oxen, three cows, one yearling, one timber cart, fifty bannels of corn eight stacks of straw, four leas and four mares, two mares of any talle, one side board, six chains and one cup board to the said Nathaniel Hearn, his executors, administrators and assigns forever, and the said Thomas Stuart for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators the aforesaid bay mare sorrel horse, two yoke of oxen, three cows, one yearling, one timber cart, fifty bannels of corn eight stacks of straw, four leas and four mares, two mares of any talle, one side board, six chains and one cup board to the said Nathaniel Hearn his executors, administrators and assigns, against me
