Wright, shall well and truly execute the office of Constable of Election district No. 8 in all things appertaining thereto, and shall also well and truly account for all moneys placed in his hands for collection, and shall also well & truly pay all sums of Money received by him, then the obligation to be void, otherwise of full force and virtue in law.
