 are held and firmly bound unto the state of Maryland in the full and
 just sum of thirty three thousand eight hundred and seven dollars and
 sixty two cents, current money of the United States, to be paid to the said state
 or its certain attorney, to the which payment well and truly to be made &
 done, we bind ourselves and each of us, our and each of our heirs, executors
 and administrators jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed
 with our seals and dated this tenth day of June in the year of our Lord
 eighteen hundred and forty four.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound William
 B. Dail appointed Collector of Dorchester County shall well and faithfully execute
 his office and the several duties required of him by law, and shall well & truly
 account for and pay to the Commissioners for Dorchester County or to their order
 the several sums of Money which he shall receive or be answerable for by Law
 at such times as the Law shall direct; then the above obligation to be void
 or else to be and remain in full force and virtue in Law.
