Sealed with our seals and dated this tenth day of June in the year of Our Lord eighteen hundred and forty four.

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden William B. Dail appointed Collector of the Direct Tax under the act of the Legislature of the state of Maryland passed the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 1842 Chapter 325 shall well and faithfully perform the duties required of him as Collector by the act aforesaid, or by law, then the above obligation to be void, or else to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.

Sealed with our seals and dated this tenth day of June in the year of Our Lord eighteen hundred and forty four.

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden William B. Dail, appointed Collector of the Direct Tax for Dorchester County, shall well and faithfully execute the office of Collector of the Direct Tax for said County and the several duties required of him by law, and shall well and truly account for and pay over to the Treasurer
