 William Jones, Trustee Know all men by these pres-
 ents that William Jones of Onebester County and State of
 Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
 dollars current money to me in hand paid by James Carroll
 of the county and State of Maryland, at and before the sealing and
 delivery hereof, the receipts whereof I do hereby acknowledge
 have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents
 do grant bargain and sell unto the said James Carroll
 his Executors administrators and assigns, the Hoggs, one
 Snel mare six years old, three year we year three cows
 three teas and furniture two tables eight chairs four stacks
 fodder one lidle and saddle all which property is now
 in my possession, to have and to hold the same descended
 property and bargained and sold to the said James
 Carroll his Executors, administrators and assigns forever
 to his and their only proper use and benefit and I the said
 William Jones for myself my Executors and administrators
 shall and will warrant and defend, by these
 presents to the said James Carroll his Executors adminis-
 trators and assigns the said descended property against me
 my Executors and administrators and against all and
 every other person or persons who may claim the
 same in any part thereof. Testimony whereof I ha-
 ve hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 27th day
 of December 1842
