

To have and to hold said Negroes above bargained and sold, or mentioned and intended so to be to the said Levin Phillips his executors, administrators and assigns forever, and we the said John Phillips and Elizabeth Perkins for ourselves our heirs executors and administrators all and singular the said Negroes & other the premises unto the said Levin Phillips his executors administrators and assigns against us the said John Phillips and Elizabeth Perkins our executors and administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents; of all and singular the said Negroes and other the premises we the said John Phillips and Elizabeth Perkins have put the said Levin Phillips in full possession by delivering to him the said Levin Phillips the Negro Woman Eliza at the sealing and delivery of these presents in the name of the whole premises hereby bargained and sold, or mentioned & intended to be so unto the said Levin Phillips as aforesaid.
