

paid by Hooper Rawleigh of the County and State aforesaid at and before the sealing and delivery hereof, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Hooper Rawleigh his executors and administrators and assigns one gray Horse, one Bay Mare, one Black Mare, two yokes of Work Steers and Yokes, one Young Steer, five milks Cows, three Huffers, four Calves, one Sow and pigs, Seven Sheep, ten Fattening Hogs, four Pigs, Breastards and furniture and all the balance of Household and Kitchen furniture, one Ox Cart, three ploughs, three Harrows and all the balance of Farming Utenshalls, all the crop of Indian Corn, about twenty one bushels of wheat, one wheat Haw, one Corn Creale, ten stacks of Black fodder and fifteen head of Sheep, all of which property is now in my possession - To have and to hold the said described property above bargained and sold to the said Hooper Rawleigh his executors and administrators and assigns forever, to his and their only proper use and benefit - And I the said Peter Carroll for myself, my executors and administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said Hooper Rawleigh, his executors, administrators and assigns the said described property against me, my executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof.
