County in the State of Maryland for and in consideration of
the sum of sixty five dollars and nine cent current money, to me in hand
paid by Turpin Wright of Dorchester County in the said State, at and before
the sealing and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof I the said
Elsy Kinney do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained and sold and
by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Turpin Wright
his executors, administrators and assigns all the goods house hold stuff
and furniture particularly mentioned expressed and contained in the sched-
ule hereunto annexed or thus herein after particularly mentioned that is
to say 2 Cows 2 yearlings, 2 young Stears 7 head of Hogs 1 ox Cart 2 old
Steers 3 Beas 2 iron pots and all and singular which said goods and
Chattels are now remaining standing and being in a certain messuage or
tenement situate in Dorchester County and now in the occupation of the said
Elsy Kinney - To have and to hold all and singular the goods house hold
stuff and furniture and other the premises above bargained and sold as
mentioned and intended so to be to the said Turpin Wright his executors
administrators and assigns forever, and I the said Elsy Kinney for
myself my heirs executors and administrators all and singular the good
house hold stuff and furniture and other the premises unto the said
