 the sum of sixty five dollars and nine cent. Current money, to me in hand  
 paid by Turpin Wright of Dorchester County in the said State, at and before  
 the sealing and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof I the said  
 Elsy Kimmy do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained and sold and  
 by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Turpin Wright  
 his executors, administrators and assigns all the goods house hold stuff  
 and furniture particularly mentioned expressed and contained in the sched-  
 ule hereunto annexed or thus hereinafter particularly mentioned that is  
 to say 2 Cows 2 Yearlings, 2 Young Steers 7 head of Hogs 1 or Cart 2 old  
 Steers 3 Beds 2 iron pots and all and singular what said goods and  
 Chattels are now remaining standing and being in a certain messuage or  
 tenement situate in Dorchester County and now in the occupation of the said  
 Elsy Kimmy - To have and to hold all and singular the goods house hold  
 stuff and furniture and other the premises above bargained and sold or  
 mentioned and intended so to be to the said Turpin Wright his executors  
 administrators and assigns forever, and I the said Elsy Kimmy for  
 myself my heirs executors and administrators all and singular the goods  
 house hold stuff and furniture and other the premises unto the said  
 Turpin Wright his executors administrators and assigns against all  
 and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will want and  
 forever defend by the presents of all and singular which said goods house  
 hold stuff and furniture and other the premises I the said Elsy Kimmy  
 have put the said Turpin Wright in full possession by delivering to him  
 the said Turpin Wright one yoke of young Steers in the name of  
 the whole at the sealing and delivering of these presents hereby bar-
