jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals
and dated this 21st day of April 1845. The Condition of the above
obligation is such that if the above bounden Soriah Layton shall
well and truly execute the office of Constable of Election District No. 2
in all things appertaining thereto, and shall well and truly account
for all moneys paid in his hands for collection, and shall also well
and truly pay all sums of money received by him, then the above
obligation to be void, otherwise of full force and virtue in law.
