 be paid to the said state or its certain attorney to which payment
 well and truly to be made and done we bind ourselves our heirs exec-
 tors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents
 sealed with our seals and dated this 21st day of April A. D. 1845.
 The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above
 bounden Henry Hollin shall well and faithfully execute the office of
 Constable in No. 5 Election district in Dorchester County in all things
 appertaining thereto and shall also well and truly account for all
 monies placed in his hands for collection and shall also well & truly
 pay all sums of money received by him agreeably to an Act of the
 General Assembly passed at November Session 1809 entitled "An Act re-
 lative to Constables Bonds" and shall well and truly account for all
 money which he shall receive on judgments and shall well and truly
 pay over the same and shall faithfully perform all acts which he
 shall perform in virtue of his office in the said County in the
 State of Maryland then the above obligation to be void else
 to remain in full force and virtue.
