Be it remembered that the following Bond was recorded on the 5th day of May 1845, to wit: Know all men by these presents that we William Richardson, Adam Richardson and John Richardson of Dorchester County, in the State of Maryland, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Maryland, in the full and just sum of Two thousand dollars, current money of the United States, to be paid to the said State or its certain attorney; to the which payment well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors & administrators jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this 5th day of May 1845.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bounden William Richardson shall well and truly execute the office of Constable of Election district No. 7, in all things appertaining thereto, and shall also well and truly account for all moneys placed in his hands for collection, and shall also well and truly pay all sums of money received by him, then the obligation to be void, otherwise of full force and virtue in law.
