Hodson, of Donchester County, in the State of Maryland, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Maryland in the full and just sum of Two thousand dollars current money of the United States, to be paid to the said State or its certain Attorney; to the which payment well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this second day of June 1845. The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden Thomas Wingate shall well & truly execute the office of Constable in Election District No. 7 in all things appertaining thereto, and shall also well and truly account for all monies placed in his hands for collection, and shall also well and truly pay all sums of money received by him, then the obligation to be void, otherwise of full force and virtue in law.
