 is to say, one Side board, one Bureau, one Secretary, one Settee, one  
 Large Clock, Six Chairs, one Carpet, Two Beds, one Bedstead & furniture,  
 one Looking Glass, Two Trunks & Contents, Two Chests & Contents, one Mahogany  
 Table, one pine Table, Shovel & Tongs and all the balance of my household
