

These presents do hereby release from Slavery, liberate, or manumit & set free the following named Negroes, to wit: Negro Woman Sarah, now about the age of Twenty three years, to serve until the age of twenty five years, then to be free. Boy Tom, son of Sarah, four years of age, to be free at the age of twenty four years. Negro girl Mary Frances, daughter of Sarah, nine months old, to be free at the age of twenty four years. Negro girl Hester, sixteen years of age in December next, the twenty fifth of said month, to serve until she arrives at the age of twenty one years, then to be free. Negro Henry, being about the age twenty five years, and Negro Andrew about the age of twelve years, and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance, and thus, the said Henry & Andrew I do declare to be henceforth free, manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude or service to me, my executors or administrators forever. And I do declare the other Negroes above named who have a time to serve, to be free, manumitted & discharged from all manner of service, or servitude, to me, my heirs, executors or administrators, when their time of service above named shall expire. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this tenth day of July one thousand eight hundred and forty six.
