 Know all men by these presents that I James Frazier of Dorchester County, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars, current money of Maryland, to me in hand paid by Peter Wheeler, of said County, at and before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I the said James Frazier have bargained and sold, conveyed and transferred, and by these presents do bargain and sell, convey and transfer unto the said Peter Wheeler, his heirs & assigns, all and singular the crop of wheat I now have sowed on the Farm where I now reside, saving and excepting fifteen bushels which I hereby reserve for seed wheat, and which is to be measured and delivered to me whenever the said crop of wheat is garnered & thrashed out. I do have and to hold the said above described property unto him the said Peter Wheeler, his heirs and assigns forever, to his and their sole use and uses forever, against me the said James Frazier, my heirs and assigns, and against all persons whatsoever, to him the said Peter Wheeler his heirs and assigns.
