Stewart, his Executors, administrators or assigns, the said one hundred and thirty dollars, current money, together with the interest for the same, after the rate aforesaid, at such time and after such manner as herein set forth and agreed for the payment thereof.  myself, my Executors and Administrators, shall and will warrant
