Michael Mitchell } I know all men by these presents that I Michael Mitchell of Dorchester County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars current money to me in hand paid by Thomas Barnett of the County & State aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and delivered unto the said Thomas Barnett one Negro slave called Mary Kenard aged eight years & one month to serve till she is thirty years of age which said Negro Mary I will warrant and defend to the said Thomas Barnett his heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns till she shall be thirty years of age against me my heirs Executors and Administrators and against every person or persons whomsoever. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my name and affixed my seal this twenty third day of December Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty six.
