I have and to hold the said Negro Man John, servant for a term of years, to be free January 1. 1853 as aforesaid, as above bargained and sold, unto the said John Jones of Col. his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, against me the said Levin Jones J.P., and my Testator and his heirs, executors and administrators, and against all and every other person or persons claiming under him or them.
