Pope his Executors, Administrators & Assigns against me the said John E. Phillips my Executors and Administrators, and against all and every other person whatsoever, with Warrant and force defend by these presents, of all and singular which funds goods and property, I have put the said Zadock H. Pope in full possession by delivering to him the said Zadock H. Pope the Gray Horse Charley, at the sealing and delivery of these presents, in the name of the whole premises hereby bargained & sold, or mentioned, or intended to be so, unto him the said Zadock H.
