the above Obligation is such that if the above bounden James N. Wright
shall will & truly execute the Office of Constable, in Election District
Number Eight, in Dorchester County, in all things appertaining thereto,
and shall will & truly account for all monies placed in his hands
for Collection, and shall also will and truly pay all sums of Money
received by him, then the above Obligation to be void, otherwise of full
force and virtue in law.
