that I Richard Pattison of Winchester County in the State of Maryland
for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars some
-out money to me in hand paid by Levin H. Wall of Winchester County
in the said State aforesaid before the sealing and delivering of these
presents the receipt whereof I the said Richard Pattison do here
-by acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by
these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Levin
H. Wall his executors administrators or assigns all the Groves and
shattels house hold stuff implements and furniture Parti-
-cular mentioned and expressed and contained in the
Schedule hereafter mentioned that is to say 3 negro men
one called Jack and one called Thomas and one other called
Stephen two horses 3 yoke of steers 3 cows and calves 15 head of
other cattle two ox carts two head of sheep one gill and harness
6 cows and 30 pigs one wheelbarrow two plows with all the
other farming utensils crop of wheat on the ground forty ban-
-els of corn 1500 lbs of salted pork 15 bushels of oats one fodder
house 3000 lbs of black fodder one lot of wheat straw ten bush-
-els Irish potatoes one milk house 4 beehives one clock 3 beds
and furniture with all the balance of the household
and kitchen furniture ten turkeys and twenty heads
of Dunchill fowls one Bag of coffee and one barrel of sugar
