


Jonathan Hurlock to have and to hold all and singular the said

 the neck, all and singular which said property unto the said
 Ann B Sullivan her executors and administrators and assigns against
 me the said William Thomas my executors and administrators
 and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
 Shall and will warrant and defend by these presents
 of all and singular which said goods and property above men-
 -tioned the said William Thomas have put the said Ann B Sulli-
 -van in full possession by delivering to her the said Ann B Sulli-
 -van me Bay mare at the sealing and delivering of these presents
 in the name of the whole premises hereby bargained and sold
 or mentioned and intended to be unto her the said Ann B Sullivan
 as aforesaid in witness whereof I here set my hand and seal this
 12th day of January 1843.

Marcellus S. Keene Doct remembered that the following Bill
 of Sale was received on the 12th day of January
 1843 from Roger L. Robertson of Winchester County
 in the State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum
 of one hundred dollars current money to me in hand paid
 by Marcellus S. Keene of said county in the said State at
 and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt
 whereof the said Roger L. Robertson as hereby acknowledged
 have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do
 grant bargain and sell unto the said Marcellus S.
 Keene his executors administrators and assigns, that is to
 say one negro woman Margaret Ann, one girl Hester and
 one negro boy William Bishop, and one Bay mare
