Travers Executors of Matthias Travers deceased. of Chester County. for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand dollars current money to us in hand paid by Charlotte Pattison of the County aforesaid. at and before the sealing and delivery hereof. the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge. have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Charlotte Pattison her Executors administrators and assigns one negro boy James to serve twenty years from the first day of June 1843. agreeably to the last will and testament of Matthias Travers proved and enrolled in the Register of Wills office of the County aforesaid in the year Eighteen hundred and thirty eight. I have and I hold the same described negro above bargained and sold to the said Charlotte Pattison her Executors administrators and assigns for the time he hath to serve to her and their own use and benefit. Travers Executors aforesaid and the said Charlotte Pattison purchaser have hereof set their hands and affixed their seals the seventeenth day of January in the year of our Lord 1843.
