Henry Shenton of Worcester County, stands indebted unto Samuel Dummer
upon a Bill obligating executed by me this day, for the sum of Two hundred
and fifty nine dollars with interest from date independent of Judgements
the D. Dummer holds against me and for the purpose of securing the
payment of the said sum of money, have agreed to execute these presents
now this indenture witnesseth that the said Henry Shenton, in consideration
of the premises & of the sum of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said
Dummer have granted, bargained & sold & by these presents do grant
bargain & sell unto the said Dummer the following property to wit -
one negro woman "Henry", one horse & carriage, fifty cords of wood now
cut, 6 yoke of broke open, 1 yoke of unbroke open, 5 cows, 3 yearlings
& calves, 20 head of hogs, 12 head of sheep, 1 timber cart, 10 ykarts, 1 farm
in utensils, 3 beds, 12 chairs & furniture, 10 chairs, one bureau, one table
one loom & gear, twenty barrels of corn, 1000 lbs of bacon, 1000 lbs of blades
& 4 stacks of top fodder, 4 stacks of straw and all the residue of my perso-
nal property of every description. I have & to hold the said property to the
said Samuel Dummer & his heirs and assigns forever, with this
proviso, that if the said Henry Shenton shall or is before the 1st day of
April in the year eighteen hundred and forty five pay to the said
Samuel Dummer the said sum of two hundred and fifty nine dollars
with interest, then this obligation to be void else of full force & virtue in
